

LGBT KEY TERMS

WHAT DOES LGBTQA+ STAND FOR?

Lesbian - Typically, women who are romantically and sexually attracted to other women. Some trans people who were assigned female at birth (AFAB) who are attracted to women also identify as lesbians.

Bisexual
A person who is romantically and sexually attracted to two (or all) genders

+

Refers to the fact that how people wish to define themselves is always changing

Queer - An umbrella term for the whole community and often a sexual orientation that is intentionally left vague.

Questioning - being uncertain of your sexual identity or gender identity

Trans - An umbrella term. Derived from the word "transgender"

Gay - A person who is romantically and sexually attracted to other people of their own gender. "Gay" is a term commonly used by men, but can also be used by other genders.

LGBT KEY TERMS

There is also the acronym **QUILT BAG**

- Queer and Questioning
- Intersex
- Lesbian
- Transgender and Two-spirit,
- Bisexual,
- Asexual and Ally
- Gay and Genderqueer.



Similarly **LGBTIQA+** stands for lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, intersex, queer/questioning, asexual and many other terms (such as non-binary and pansexual)

PANSEXUAL FLAG

Refers to a woman who has an emotional, romantic and/or sexual orientation towards women <i>Key term</i>	The steps a trans person may take to live in the gender with which they identify. <i>Key term</i>	Umbrella term for people whose gender identity doesn't sit comfortably with 'man' or 'woman' <i>Key term</i>
the fear or dislike of someone, based on prejudice or negative attitudes, beliefs or views about lesbian, gay or bi people <i>Key term</i>	when a person experiences discomfort or distress because there is a mismatch between their sex assigned at birth and their gender identity <i>Key term</i>	A man who has an emotional, romantic and/or sexual orientation towards women or to a woman who has an emotional, romantic and/or sexual orientation towards men <i>Key term</i>
A heterosexual and cisgender person who supports equal civil rights, gender equality, LGBT social movements <i>Key term</i>	Refers to a man who has an emotional, romantic and/or sexual orientation towards men <i>Key term</i>	Someone whose gender identity is the same as the sex they were assigned at birth <i>Key term</i>
Someone who is figuring out their gender identity and figuring out how they want <i>Key term</i>	Sexually attracted not exclusively to people of one particular gender; attracted to both men and women. <i>Key term</i>	An umbrella term for sexual and gender minorities who are not heterosexual or cisgender. Originally meaning "peculiar" <i>Key term</i>
Somebody who has genetic or biological features that don't fit the stereotypical definitions of female or male <i>Key term</i>	The fear or dislike of someone based on the fact they are trans, including the denial/refusal to accept their gender identity. <i>Key term</i>	Having no sexual feelings or desires towards others <i>Key term</i>



LGBT Activists defy law by using football shirts to display pride flag in Russia

While every football fan in Russia is flying their country's flag as a way of supporting their team for the World Cup, those in the LGBTQA+ community are not quite as fortunate. In 2013, the Russian government enacted a federal law which **criminalised the promotion and distribution of materials** in support of non-traditional relationships to minors. This **includes the rainbow flag**, which is a symbol used all around the world for LGBTQA+ people to express their pride and diversity. However, in an extraordinary display of resilience, activists have found a way to fly the flag in public for the month of Pride - and even better, they are using Russia's hosting of the football tournament to display it.

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



