Higham Lane School can confirm that a Year 7 student at the School has tested positive for Covid-19. Our first thoughts are with the student and any family members affected and we hope they will make a rapid recovery.

It is also our priority to protect and maintain the confidentiality of the student involved.

In line with advice from Public Health England, we have reviewed all possible close contacts. We have consequently asked 52 Year 7 students to remain at home for 14 days from the last day of contact with the student, to self-isolate. These students will return to school after half term on Monday, 2nd November.

The School remains safe and open to all other students to continue attending as normal.

Our absolute priority is the safety and wellbeing of our students and staff. We have followed the guidance from the Department for Education and Public Health Warwickshire in full. This has minimised the risk to other students and staff.
