My Ed App

Work for Sick Students

If your child is absent from school for a short-term illness (not isolating for Covid reasons) and you would like work for your child please note that lessons cannot currently be provided on Google Classroom but we recommend that they work through the following:

- Look at their classroom on Google Classroom to see if the teacher has set any work for students who are self-isolating for a period of up to 14 days. They can also complete this work.
- Use the many online resources that are available for each subject. For example, MyMaths, Linguascope, QuizLit, Seneca Learning to secure their knowledge and understanding.
- Complete work using their Revision Guides.
- Look through the archived lessons from the summer term when they were learning through Google Classroom - recap and review topics that you studied. They can still complete the subject quizzes for example.
- Use their Knowledge Organiser booklet to recap and review knowledge that they are currently working on.
- Ensure all their FOTs from teacher feedback have been completed.
- Complete any incomplete questions from Knowledge Booklets or other lesson resources.
- Read for pleasure using their private reading book.
