When I saw they offered paid degree apprenticeships – where you work and study simultaneously, and don't pay any university fees – applying felt like a no-brainer.

It's been brilliant to gain an understanding of the large range of departments that sit within BMW Group. You change department every four months as part of the apprenticeship, and I've developed a real understanding and depth of knowledge for the different roles and responsibilities within each one, along with how they all fit together within the wider business.

The time BMW invest in supporting their apprentices is amazing. Everyone is willing to help you. It doesn't matter if it's with university work or work-related projects. If you need a helping hand, you always feel like someone is ready to lend you one. At the beginning of my apprenticeship, I was placed alongside a number of experienced technicians within the prototype department, enabling me to gain good product knowledge that I've then been able to use elsewhere in the business.



The experience and confidence I've gained since beginning my apprenticeship has also really improved my engineering skills. Assisting with the building and testing of prototype engine builds was a real highlight of my experience so far. It was nerve-racking at first to be given such a huge responsibility – helping ensure the engines adhere to legal requirements and BMW's high standards – but it was a brilliant experience that I learnt a lot from.

Daunting as the transition from school to the working world was at first, everyone at BMW was really welcoming and understanding. I've thoroughly enjoyed my three and a half years here and I'm excited for the future.
