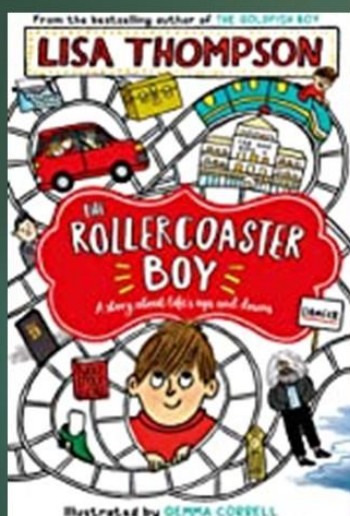

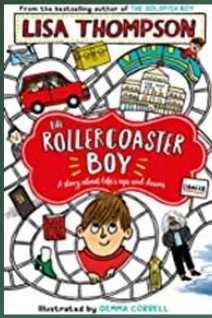
Lateral Flow Tests
