

Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to you at the end of what has been a momentous week in our nation's history. Monday's State Funeral for Queen Elizabeth II will live long in the memory for its mixture of poignancy, pomp and ceremony. A fitting tribute to our nation's longest reigning monarch.

This week has marked a significant milestone for our Year 7s with them now making their own way to lessons and joining the rest of the school on the playground at break and lunchtime. Although the size of the building can be quite daunting compared with their primary schools, they are generally managing to find their way round (with a little help from their maps in some cases!) and if they are unsure, are asking teachers or fellow students to direct them.

In terms of our older year groups, voting is currently underway for our Junior Leadership Team. The Junior Leadership Team (or JLT) is an important part of school life and an excellent opportunity for the students to develop their leadership skills. JLT members contribute ideas to the running of the school through regular meetings with me and Mr Ireland (who coordinates JLT), organise events and gauge student opinion. Two members of JLT are selected to become Head Students for the School.

Year 11 students have been set the challenge of attending as many revision classes between now and their trial exams (which start on the 31 Oct, the Monday after half term) through the launch of the Loyalty Card. For every 10 sessions attended, students qualify for money off their prom ticket or year book or receive a Love 2 Shop voucher. We have added certain stipulations this year in terms of which subjects they need to attend as part of their 10 sessions in order to encourage them to attend revision sessions across a range of subjects. If you have a son or daughter in Year 11, please ask to see their Loyalty Card to see how many sessions they have attended!

Thank you to those parents/carers who attended the Year 7, 10 and 12 Parents' Information Evenings this week. As mentioned in last week's newsletter, your support for these events is always greatly appreciated and I hope that you found it useful in terms of how to support your child this academic year.
