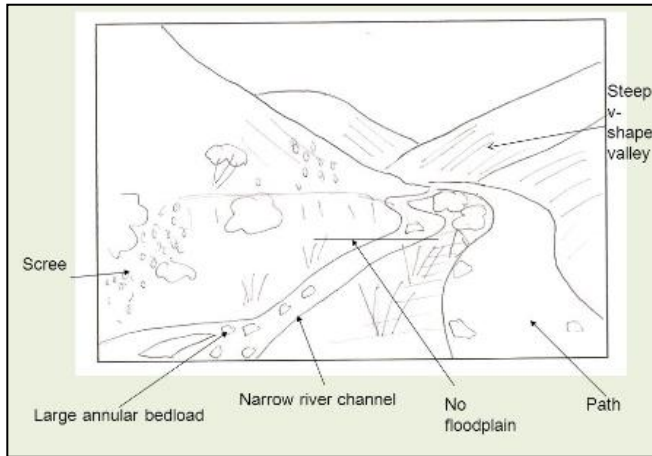


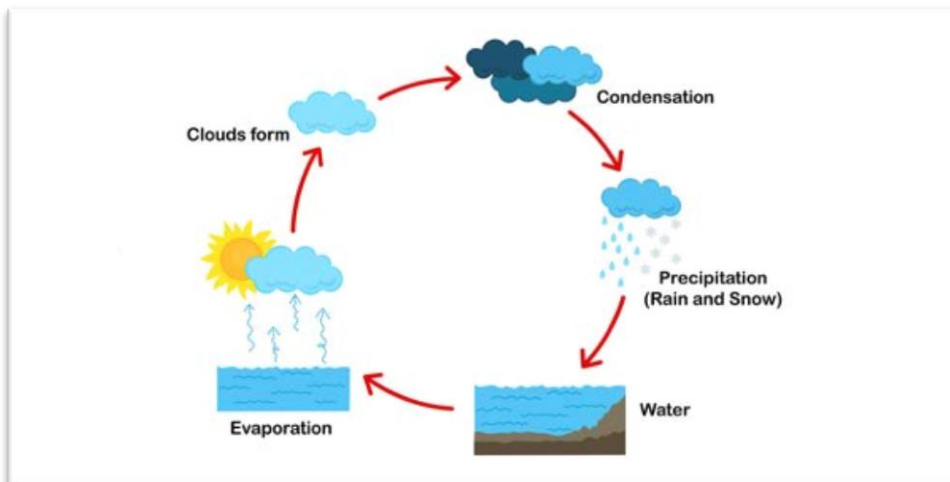

Labelling

- **Physical geography** is looking at the completely natural features of a place
- **Human Geography** is looking at the man-made features of a place.

The Water Cycle – the circulation of water from land, sea and air



Keywords

Precipitation – snow, rain, hail

Condensation - the conversion of water vapour or gas to a liquid

Evaporation - the conversion of water into vapour

Why people migrate?

Migration is the movement of people from one place to another.

Some people are 'pushed' (forced to leave) others are pull (attracted to a new place)

Earthquake, volcanic eruption	Good climate/weather
War and unrest	Better schools
Lack of work	Good paid jobs
Poor housing	To be with friends and family
Lack of health care – doctors, nurses, hospitals	Variety of entertainment
Crime	Open space

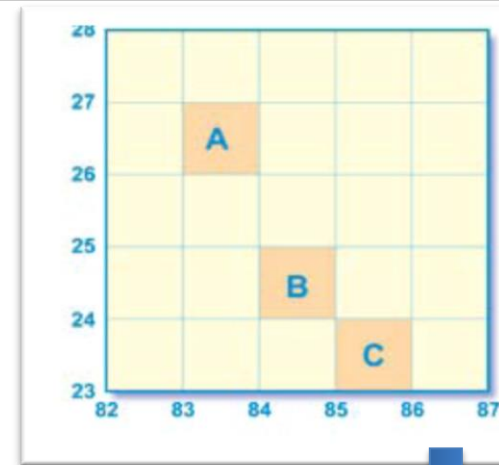

G. Recycle	To use things again instead of throwing them away
H. Weather	What the atmosphere is like, e.g. hot, windy....
I. Pollution	When harmful things go into the air, sea or land
