**Top Tips:**

- Ensure you are using the correct **technique** for the questions. Start by **highlighting the command words** in the question and checking how many marks it is worth.
- 6 and 8 mark questions, get **straight to the point**, don't rephrase the question. Remember to include both elements of the question and link these together.
- For an 8 mark question you must do a minimum of two points that are detailed.
- **Identify your areas of weakness/ gaps in knowledge** and address these through revision.
- **Ensure** you are using appropriate **terminology**.
- Get **someone to test you** on the key terms and studies. Make yourself **cue cards** with a question on one side and the answer on the other.
- Try as many past questions as you can. Bring them to your teacher who will be happy to give you feedback on them.
- Don't forget that the knowledge booklets/**revision guide** contains practice exam questions. If you complete these hand them in so that you can get feedback. The exam board we use is Cambridge Nationals.
- You must know each Topic Area (4 in total) in detail.
- Remember – you have completed 60% of your overall grade through non-examined assessment (coursework) – this exam will make a big difference to your achievement!
- Don't forget that your **revision guide** contains practice exam questions. If you complete these hand them in so that you can get feedback. The exam board we use is Cambridge Nationals.
