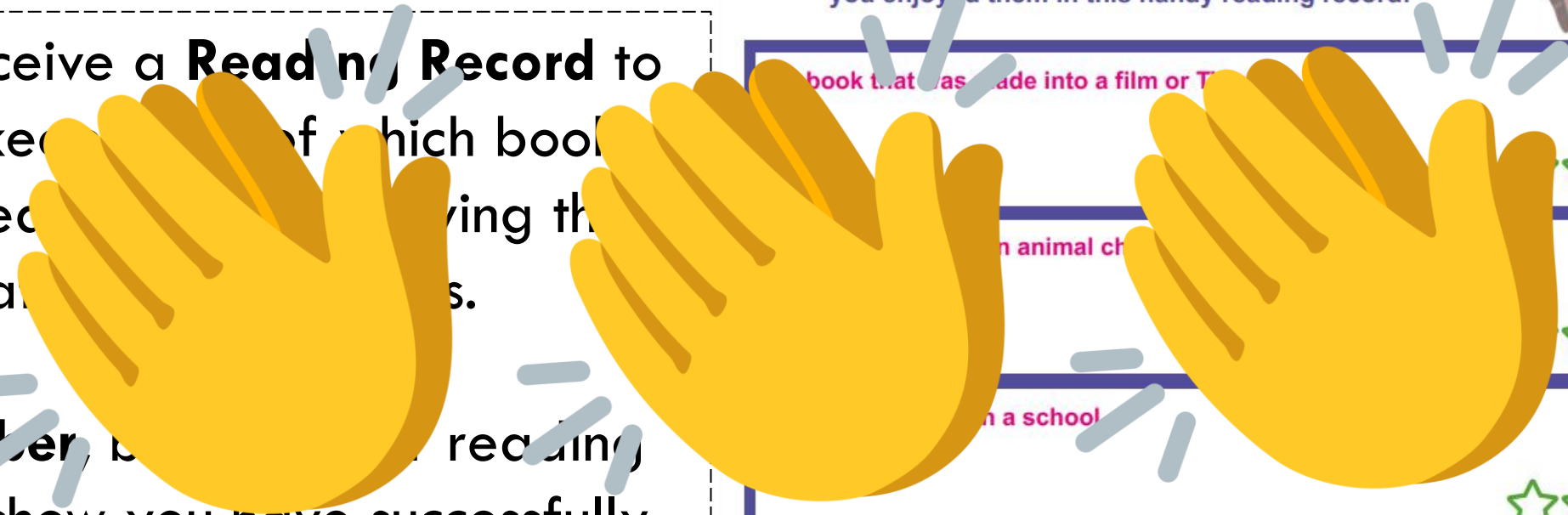


YOUR READING RECORD
